This system is divided into three modules: the **Activity Based Costing (ABC)** Module is utilized to collect and report data against departmental work activities; the **Performance Module** is utilized to create and modify the Department's Strategic Plan, and allow for the reporting of results against strategic plan measures, as well as enable bureaus to manage their on bureau-specific measures; the **Executive Dashboard** is an at-a-glance status report to the highest level Interior executives (the Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Assistant Secretaries, and Deputy Assistant Secretaries, Bureau and Office Heads, etc.) covering the most important issues of the day or period. The data/information contained in the dashboard is subject to frequent change as national events and focuses change.

The Appraisal Request & Review Tracking System is a secure web application that provides Bureaus (BLM, BOR, FWS and NPS) with a centralized, unified process for submission of real estate appraisal requests and valuations to the Department OS Office of Valuation Services (OVS). The business logic is complex but ARRTS simplifies the process for routing requests for approval and assignment as well as a mechanism for tracking and reporting on appraisal requests. ARRTS features:

- **Now in Read Only Mode & was replaced by Interior Valuation Information System (IVIS) in May 2011**
- Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption for secure user sessions..
- Audit trail information tracked for various activities in the system.
- Role-based and agency-based read/write access to the system.
- Automated status e-mail notifications assist approval process throughout entire routing lifecycle.
- Ability to attach large files such as maps and real estate appraisals for any given project.
- Online Help Utility including an extensive User's Guide.
- DOI University Online Training available (one for bureau users and one for appraisers).
- Extensive reporting capabilities with export to Microsoft Word and Excel formats.
- Admin Tool to modify user information and roles as well as ability to change reference table data.

EFTS is the technology foundation that not only provides DOI with the capability to track and coordinate its FOIA requests, and litigations centrally, but also enables a distributed process across the DOI enterprise. EFTS allows DOI FOIA Officers to add, update, find, and track the FOIA and Privacy Act requests, litigations from their desks more efficiently, ensure consistency in responses, and facilitate preparation of the annual report to DOJ/Congress. Updates are immediately available to anyone who accesses data and will provide a complete, timely, and accurate account of individual FOIA requests and their status. The application also provides various reports and logs to better assist the DOI FOIA officers when working with their FOIA requests.

EFTS is a Java/J2EE web application system deployed within the DOI IT infrastructure. Users access EFTS via a web browser and have access to various parts of EFTS based on their user roles and privileges. All data for EFTS is tracked in a relational database that is normalized to provide data integrity and reduce data redundancy. It is designed to take advantage of the latest development environment using web-based, thin client solutions and the Department of the Interior's Intranet.



Opinion on Attendance of Events in Skyboxes

The Office of Government Ethics has recently provided guidance to Designated Agency Ethics Officials on the valuation of gifts of attendance to an event in a skybox or private suite. As the ethics regulations state, employees generally may not accept any gifts from a prohibited source (that is anyone who does business with your agency, seeks to do business with your agency, is regulated by your agency, or could be affected by the performance or non-performance of your official duties) or if the gift is given to the employee due to their official duties. However, if an employee were to pay fair market value for the gift, the employee may accept it. The Office of Government Ethics notice states that fair market value for attendance at an event in a skybox or private suite would be the sum value of all incidentals offered (food, parking, etc.) as well as the price of the most expensive ticket to the event available to the general public. In this case, if an employee is offered attendance to an event in a skybox or private suite from a prohibited source or because of the employee's official position, in order to accept the gift the employee would have to pay whoever offers the gift, the equivalent cost of all incidentals as well as the value of the most expensive ticket to the event open to the general public. Additionally, if you receive a gift that is not from a prohibited source or offered to you due to your official position, you may have reporting requirements for the gift on your financial disclosure form. The National Invasive Species Council (NISC) was established by Executive Order (EO) 13112 to ensure that Federal programs and activities to prevent and control invasive species are coordinated, effective and efficient.

NISC members are the Secretaries and Administrators of 13 federal departments and agencies to provide high-level coordination on invasive species and is co-chaired by the Secretaries of Commerce, Agriculture, and the Interior (see NISC Organizational Chart).

EO 13112 defines invasive species as "...an alien (or non-native) species whose introduction does, or is likely to cause economic or environmental harm or harm to human health". Only a small proportion of non-native species are invasive (See ISAC Definitions White Paper.)

NISC receives advice from and consults with the Invasive Species Advisory Committee, a group of nonfederal experts and stakeholders chartered under the Federal Advisory Committee Act of 1972.

The CIO consults with the Department's Chief Financial Officer to assure that Interior information technology programs and activities are carried out in a cost-effective manner, and that financial and related program information is reliable, consistent, and timely. The CIO deals with top-level officials in the Office of Management and Budget, other federal agencies, and appears to testify before Congressional committees.
