HIGHLIGHT: HUD's response to the tsunami disaster in American Samoa

-  Within 24 hours of disaster, HUD advised American Samoa of options to reprogram HUD Program funds for disaster relief.
-  Within 48 hrs received tsunami impact status report from ASG representatives managing the HUD programs.
-  October 2, 2009 started participation on the FEMA American Samoa Housing Support Team.
-  October 2- 6, 2009 provided FEMA American Samoa Housing Support Team with background information on American Samoa's housing conditions prior to the disaster.
-  October 7, 2009 provided FEMA American Samoa Housing Support Team with housing drawings used by American Samoa to build HOME Program assisted new

housing. (The drawings were later used as the foundation for the rebuilding of housing destroyed by the tsunami.)

 October 2009 completed HUD participation with FEMA American Samoa Housing Support Team.

 November 2009 – January 2010 continue program support and assist American Samoa recover program files as necessary.
